Maddie Riewoldt was just 26 years old when she tragically died of a Bone Marrow Failure Syndrome called Aplastic Anaemia. Maddie was diagnosed at 21 years, and for five tough years she put up an incredibly brave fight. She spent those years enduring several bone marrow transplants, hundreds of blood transfusions, and ongoing treatments.

Maddie fought her battle with inspiring determination and courage. When her fight was ending in February 2015, she asked her family to make her a promise; Maddie wanted nobody else to go through what she did.

**Every 3 days an Australian is diagnosed with a Bone Marrow Failure Syndrome.**

Tragically, most are children and young adults, and 50% will not survive. Thousands more live with complex medical challenges and ongoing health risks, including a significantly higher chance of developing cancer.

A Bone Marrow Failure Syndrome diagnosis is deeply isolating for patients and their families. Navigating the complex treatment journey, accessing reliable information, and finding appropriate support resources can be confusing and overwhelming.

We urgently need new therapeutic and support options to treat these devastating conditions and improve outcomes for patients and their families.



# OUR IMPACT



Over the past decade, Maddie Riewoldt's Vision has driven significant progress in Bone Marrow Failure Syndrome research, while providing vital support to patients and their families across Australia.

We established the Centre of Research Excellence in Bone Marrow Biology - the first of its kind in Australia - to bring researchers together, foster collaboration and accelerate innovation in this critical field.

To date, we have committed \$10 million across 36 cutting-edge research projects, including two clinical trials involving more than 400 patients - helping translate research into real-world impact.

Our funded researchers have gone on to secure an additional \$24.2 million in external funding, significantly amplifying the reach and long-term impact of our investment.

Alongside our research leadership, we deliver Australia's only National Support Services dedicated to Bone Marrow Failure Syndromes, providing education, resources and emotional support to more than 170 patients and families nationwide.
